Continental New York ELA Assessment Practice

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New York ELA Assessment Practice is an online program that reinforces Next Generation Learning Standards and familiarize students with multiple choice and open response question types. There are two components to the ELA scores: computer-scored multiple choice and teacher scored open response.

The chart below shows the maximum value for each set of question types by grade level. Scores will not be final until teachers review and score the 9 open response questions.
