

# WEEKLY PACING: WEEKS 3 AND 4

In Weeks 3 and 4 of your implementation, students will be on pace to finish at least 1 story unit every two weeks. In your BrightFish Reading teacher page, you can monitor progress and review story data.

## Week 3:

**Story Completion Goals:** Set clear expectations for weekly time on task (TOT) and story completion goals in BrightFish Reading and track progress right from your teacher dashboard.

**Performance Data** – These reports will help you monitor and remediate:

- Class Snapshot (below): View weekly TOT, stories completed and summary activity scores.
- Student Details and Student Progress: View error data and look for trends in student scores.
- Daily Review: See notifications for any student work to prioritize who needs help.

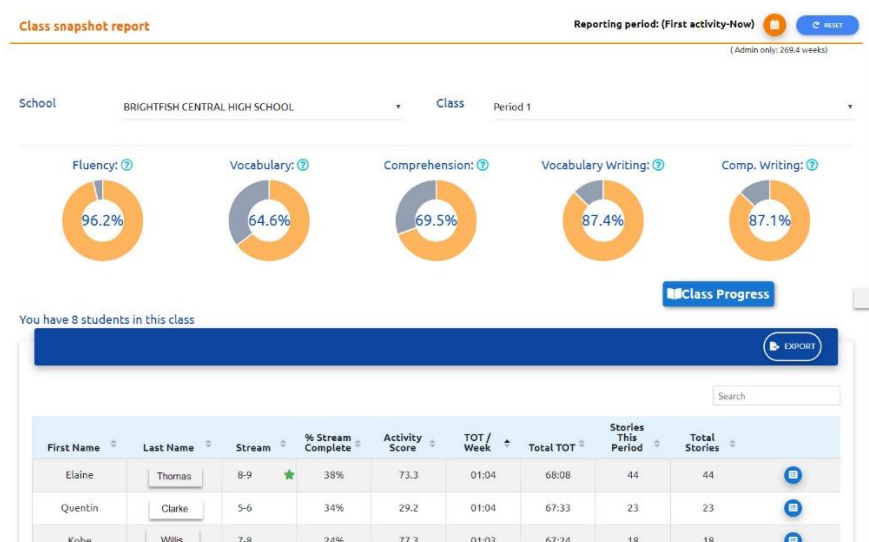


Figure 1: The Class Snapshot Report gives you a performance profile for the class and individual scores for students.

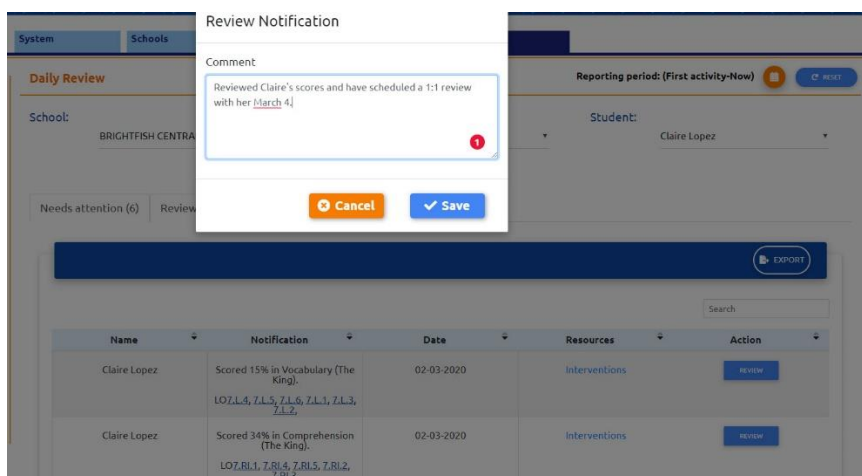


Figure 2: The Daily Review report lets you see who needs help and provides a way to document your remediations.



# WEEKLY PACING: WEEKS 3 AND 4

## Week 4:

**Data Chats** – Once your students start completing story units, you can use BrightFish data to provide small group and 1:1 remediation. These reports will provide you with the data for these discussions:

- Student Details report: Lexile growth, completion time, summary scores.
- Student Progress report: View errors and skill areas that need improvement. In the Vocabulary column, for example, you can see the summary percentage score from the multiple choice, synonym/antonym and fill in the blanks activities. To view the responses and error data, click on the percentage scores.
